Considering the purpose and context of the organization, and the condition of the environment in which we operate, the management of Go North West (GNW) is committed to the continual improvement of the Environmental Management System (EMS) to enhance environmental performance, by following the principles and requirements of the ISO 14001 standard.

The framework for environmental management and setting environmental objectives is defined in the Manual. Go North West (GNW) are acting to protect the environment by preventing and eliminating environmental pollution through:

- Continual improvement of the EMS and the annual review of environmental objectives and targets.
- Continual raising of environmental awareness within the organisation through education in the prevention of environmental pollution, and preservation of natural resources.
- Continual fulfillment of all compliance obligations, including legal compliance.
- The improvement of hazardous and non-hazardous waste management.
- Increase in the use of renewable energy sources to reduce non-renewable energy consumption
- Activities that emerge from the context of the organization
- Decrease in environmental pollution, and prevent degradation and damage to the environment through the implementation of environmental procedures
- Decrease of adverse impact on water, soil, air, and biodiversity.
